### UCL Play-off football match BSC Young Boys – Maccabi Haifa FC, 29 August 2023

**The Champions League play-off football match takes place between BSC Young Boys and Maccabi Haifa FC on Tuesday, 29 August 2023 at 21:00. The Bern Cantonal Police, BSC Young Boys and other partners are committed to ensuring spectators' safety. Our security measures can only be effective with your support**

Dear Football fans

Welcome to Bern.

In the Canton of Bern, international and top-league football games require authorisation. In addition, the following conditions must be met for football games that are held in the City of Bern:

- Visitors arriving by coach or minibus must be transported directly to the stadium (see enclosed map)
- The cantonal police notifies the drivers of the precise location for embarking and disembarking
- Fan marches are generally prohibited
- If the defined requirements are not met, the authorities have the right to impose stricter regulations. This may be done at short notice, e.g. if it becomes apparent before the match that some safety-relevant regulations are not going to be met

### Arrival and departure by train

The official train station for the event is Bern-Wankdorf. It is situated near the stadium.

The Bern-Wankdorf station is regularly served by trains from Bern Main Station (central station).

### Arrival and departure by car

The police kindly ask car drivers to use the assigned parking places only.

Please take motorway exit, Bern-Neufeld.

However, parking facilities are very limited, and the police recommend using public transport to travel to this event.

### Arrival and departure by coach

The police kindly ask the coach drivers only to use the parking spaces for coaches near the stadium that are specially provided for this occasion.

Please take motorway exit, Bern-Neufeld.

### City centre fan point

The local authorities in the City of Bern have designated Aarberggasse as a meeting point in the city centre. There are many bars and restaurants in Aarberggasse and the surrounding area.

### Bus to / from stadium (see map)

The Number 20 bus stops near the stadium / visitors' entrance / coach parking area (before and after the match).

From the city centre, you travel to the stadium by taking the Number 20 bus from the Bollwerk stop close to the meeting point for fans (see map).



If you have any questions, BernMobil personnel or our specially assigned police officers will be happy to assist you.

**General information**

The stadium opens at 19:30. Spectators will have to remain in their sector for a maximum of 30 minutes after the match. We kindly ask you to abide by the rules of conduct in the stadium.

Our uniformed officers from the Bern Cantonal Police dialogue group, recognisable by their neon orange vests, and the contact person for fans, wearing a neon blue vest, will be happy to offer you information and support. 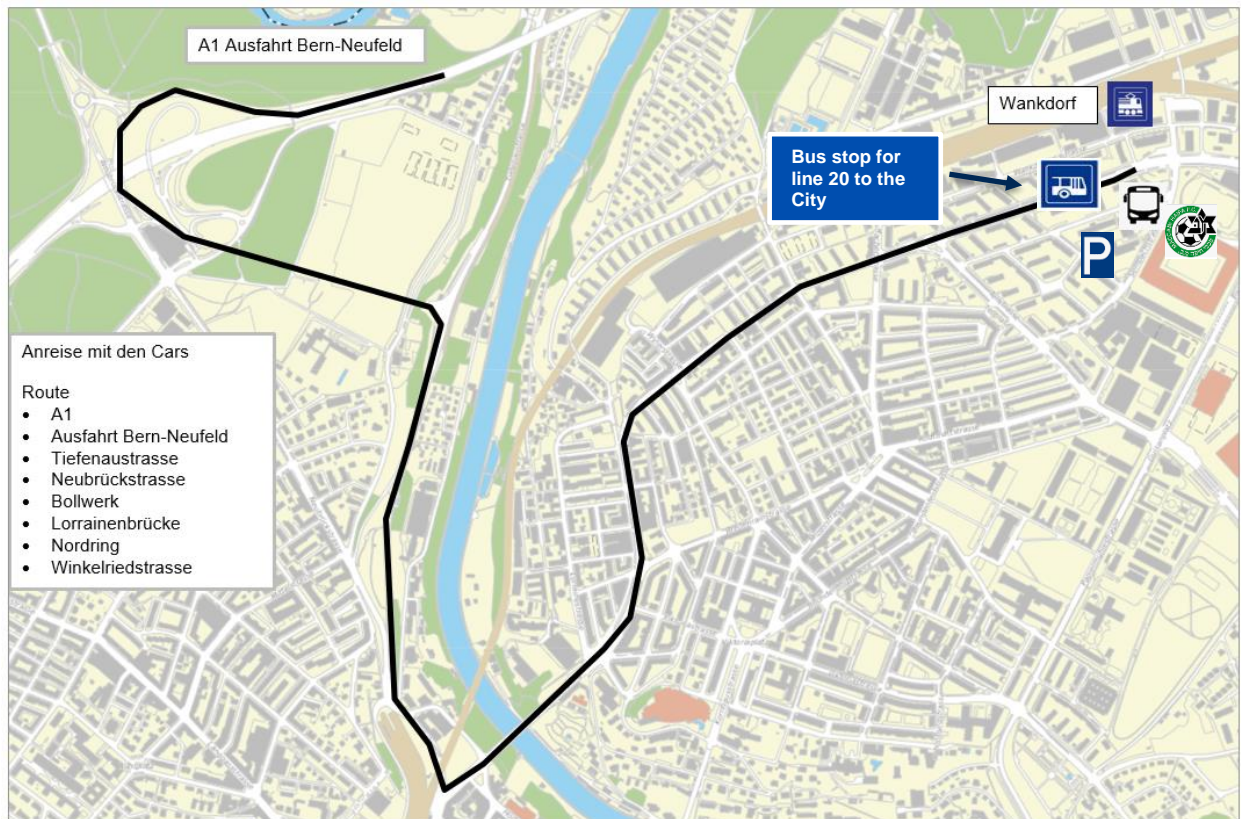

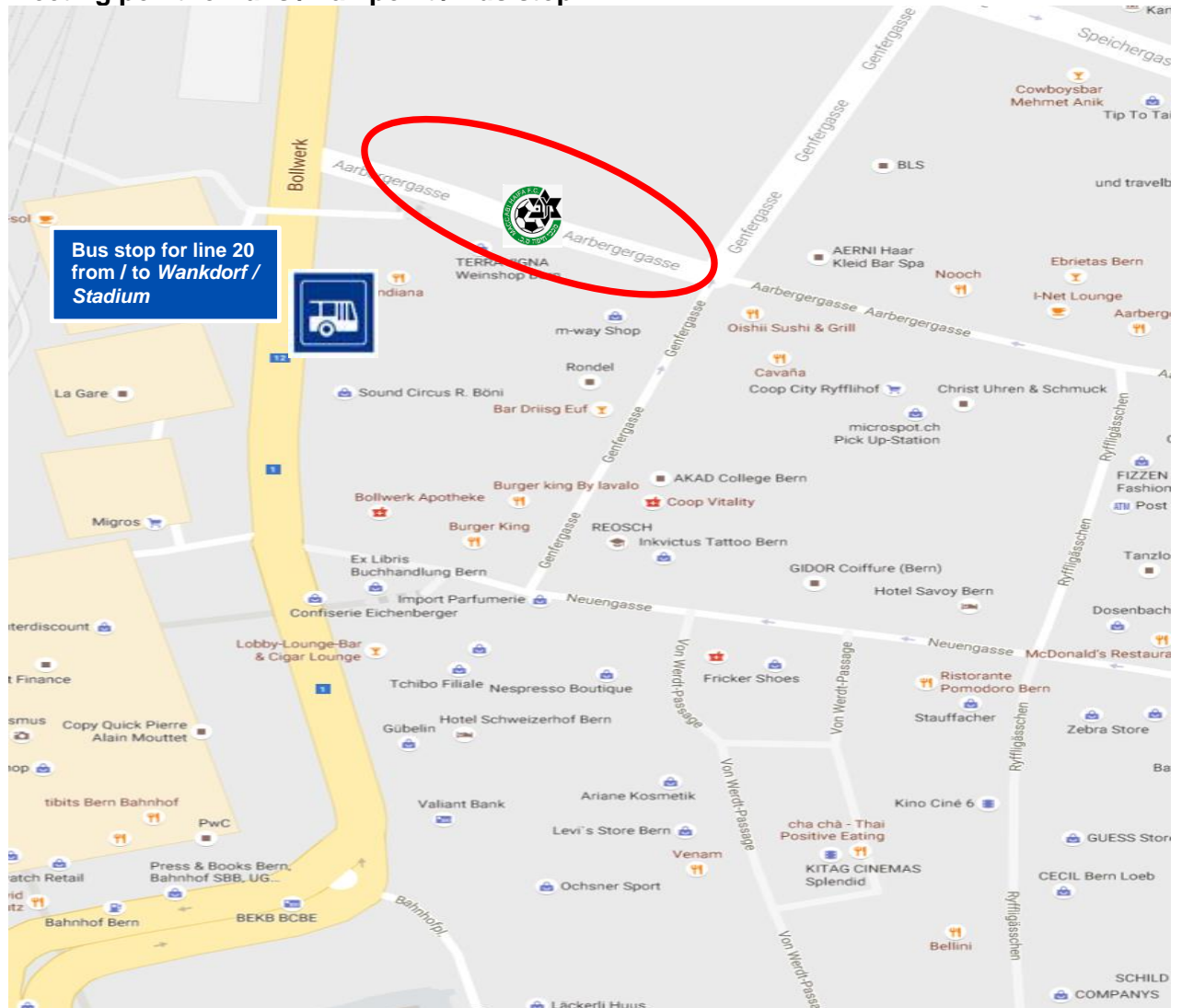
